Dr. Scott B. Rae is currently Dean of the Faculty, Professor of Christian Ethics and Chair of the Department of Philosophy at Talbot School of Theology, Biola University in La Mirada Ca. He has an M.A. and Ph.D. in Social Ethics at the University of Southern California, Los Angeles, CA. He earned a B.A.S. in Economics from Southern Methodist University and a Th. M. from Dallas Theological Seminary.

Dr. Rae is the author of *The Ethics of Commercial Surrogate Motherhood*, Praeger Publishing, *Moral Choices: An Introduction to Ethics*, Zondervan, *Brave New Families: Biblical Ethics and Reproductive Technologies*, Baker, and *Beyond Integrity: A Judeo-Christian Approach to Business Ethics* (with Kenman L. Wong), Zondervan, *Bioethics: A Christian Approach in a Pluralistic Age* (with Paul M. Cox, Eerdmans), *Body and Soul: Human Nature and the Crisis in Ethics*, (with JP Moreland, Intervarsity Press), and *Biotechnology and the Human Good*, (with C. Ben Mitchell, et. al.), Georgetown University Press. He is also the author of numerous journal articles in bioethics, his work having appeared in journals such as the *Journal of Women's Health*, the *Southern California Journal of Law and Women's Studies*, *Christian Research Journal*, *Christian Bioethics* and *The Medical Ethics Advisor*.

Dr. Rae has served as ethics consultant for Providence Holy Cross Medical Center, Mission Hills, CA, Providence St. Joseph Medical Center, Burbank, CA, Western Medical Center, Santa Ana, CA, and Coastal Communities Hospital, Santa Ana, CA for 15+ years. He speaks widely in the area of medical ethics to physicians, nurses and hospital administrators and business ethics to companies and executives.

He is a member of the Society of Christian Ethics, American Society for Bioethics and the Humanities, and the Society of Business Ethics. He is a fellow for the Center for Bioethics and Human Dignity and the Wilberforce Forum.
